Accessing Quality Information on Dairy Farmers of Ontario's Website

Dairy Farmers of Ontario's (DFO) website at www.milk.org is a one-stop source of information for producers, industry partners and the public regarding milk production and the dairy industry in general. The site is updated on a regular basis.

Producer-specific information and data are also available in the password-protected section of the DFO website. Dairy producers are encouraged to log on to the DFO website regularly to access their test results. Web access is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Producers who do not yet have web access can contact DFO IT Support to obtain their **primary** and **secondary** passwords, and then follow the instructions under "Accessing Test Results for the First Time" below.

- The **primary** password grants access to all available information including the Milk Statement and the ability to place a bid or an offer on the quota exchange. This password should be protected and not given out to anyone.
- The **secondary** password limits access to daily pickups as well as composition and quality test results. Producers may, at their discretion, provide the secondary password to veterinarians, nutritionists, dairy equipment dealers or other service providers.

ACCESSING TEST RESULTS FOR THE FIRST TIME (for both primary and secondary passwords users)

1. On your web browser, type www.milk.org, enter your Username and Password and click "Enter".



2. Check your contact information and click "Submit". Note the premise identification (PID) number in the upper right corner.

3. Change your password by entering the password you received from IT Support in the field entitled "Enter your current password" and your new password into the two other fields. Click "Submit".

Your new password must be between 6 and 12 characters in length and must contain at least one alphabetic character (A to Z, a to z) and one numeric character (0 to 9). Your password is case-sensitive, meaning you must remember whether you use uppercase (A) or lowercase (a) when you type it in.

4. Click "Continue".

5. You should now see the same screen as in Step 1. Enter your Username and new Password again and click "Enter".
6. Click on "Daily Test Results" on the left-hand menu. Here you can view your daily test results. Test results in the elevated range appear in yellow, while results in the penalty range appear in red.
