



National Mastitis Council (NMC) Regional Meeting Returns to Southern Ontario in June 2018

In the summer of 1999, the first NMC Regional Meeting outside of the USA was held in Waterloo, Ontario. Nineteen years later, the meeting returns to central Canada from June 20 to 22, 2018.

The meeting will be held in Guelph, Ontario – about 45 minutes west of Toronto – on the beautiful University of Guelph campus. The NMC Regional meeting, hosted jointly with the Ontario Association of Bovine Practitioners and the Dairy Farmers of Ontario, will provide the best current mastitis and milk quality information to leading dairy producers, veterinarians, and advisors.

The 3-day program includes a full day of short-courses followed by a dinner banquet with keynote speaker on June 20th, a day of formal presentations on June 21st, and a day of farm tours on June 22nd. Key topics to be covered include: implementation of selective dry cow therapy programs, bedding options and their impact on udder health, and maintaining the highest milk quality when transitioning to robotic milking systems.
